#### IELTS 6666 or Equivalent Temporary Residence Transition Stream

- You should have TSS
- Usually, you must have worked for your employer full-time for at least 3 years
- You must be nominated by your employer

\*Candidates must not be over 40 years of age at the time of commencing this program to meet stage 2 requirements.

\*As a general guideline for interested candidates, the minimum annual salary for candidates is approximately AUD\$54,000. This amount can vary depending on each individual case and employer.
